



The 2025-2026 re-enrollment deadline was last Friday, March 7. **If you have not re-enrolled your child yet, please do so ASAP.**





Each class is invited to bring in *new items* to their *homerooms by Friday, April 11th*. The Leadership Council will be assembling the baskets, and they will be delivered to Cedarcrest on Holy Thursday afternoon. The needed items are as follows:

Preschool = Crayons

Kindergarten = Markers (washable)

5th grade = Stamp pads

7th grade = Construction paper









