Dear Parents and Staff,

It is wonderful to see the support that our families give to SJRS and OLMA.

For example, we just received a check for \$392.04 from the shopping that parents did during Hannaford Supermarket's promotion last spring.

Also, this Tuesday, students enjoyed a wonderful show by Ashuelot Concerts, performed by SJRS parents Louisa Stonehill and Nicholas Burns. The music was beautiful and inspiring, and students had many questions about the violin and music in general.

And for those parents who were not able to attend the presentation that was given on Monday night, the parents who did attend voiced their commitment to assist our schools and programs and asked how they could help improve the financial health of our schools. What was shared was that the school has a large debt with the Diocese of Manchester, and that we will be working on an incremental plan to bring down our debt and grow the schools. Increased enrollment, fundraising, and watching expenses will be the three parts of this plan. I will be looking for input from staff and families; the venue for this has not been determined yet. Those who did attend received a copy of the letter of support from our Superintendent of Schools, David Thibault, and next week, a recap of the information shared and the letter will be made available online to families.

As we journey through this Advent Season, it is very encouraging to hear from parents that they love what our teachers do every day in the classrooms and it is even better to hear from students that they love coming to school every day, or as one 6th Grader put it, "All the teachers are really nice, and the teaching is really good."

Thank you to our awesome teachers and staff and thank you to our supportive families!


