Dear Parents, Students, and Staff,

The cooler weather is definitely here, and parents may hear their students talking about the 'extra efficient' heat that is now working at both of our schools. To fill in some details: in July, we were looking at the prospect of a new heating system, a very large expense. But thanks to the professional abilities of Mr. Bill Baker, who is also one of our school parents, the old boiler is now back working and putting out heat and keeping our classrooms at SJRS toasty warm. The system at OLMA has also been serviced and some minor repairs done, and is already being used daily. Mr. Baker is still working on some thermostats and valves, but it's great to know that we will have good heat all winter.

He has been assisted in this by Rick Cavallero who is overseeing the Facilities Committee of our new School Advisory Board. To bring families up to date about the Board, we have been meeting since August, and the members are Fr. Alan Tremblay, Ann Szot, Cheryl Mihaly, Annie Pearson, Jon Farina, and myself. Another member, taken from our incipient Home and School Association, will also be added. The Board has begun to look at the Mission Statement for both schools which was one of the directives from the NEASC Accreditation Committee. The Committee said that we should revise the Mission to more reflect our Catholic values.

Any revision of a Mission Statement includes input from all stakeholders. While the Board is doing its part, and the school staff did some reviewing of the Mission, the process will necessarily take longer as we seek to authentically reflect what SJRS and OLMA are and what we do together as a faith and school community. Parents will be asked in a more formal way, in a later newsletter, to give ideas about the Mission.

Parents and families-please start thinking about what you'd change, add, or keep the same about our mission.



Once your tickets are sold, you may send the stubs/money back into school at any time. They can be given to your student's homeroom teacher or directly to Ashley Brown in the Main Office.





1:30pm -- Trunk-or-Treat Halloween Parade

The parade will start inside, exit out the playground door, proceed through the parking lot, and re-enter the building at the main front doors. Four faculty vehicles will be decorated and distributing candy. Parents are welcome to attend the parade. The parking lot is the perfect place to gather and watch. Parents may bring candy to distribute, if they wish.

1:45-2:00pm -- Snacks in the gym (PK/K in their classrooms)

2:30pm -- Students return to classrooms. PK-5 students may stay in their costumes for dismissal.

A few notes to help you plan accordingly.
