We have once again partnered with New Hampshire Dance Institute (NHDI) to bring the NHDI Year-Long Program to our students for this school year. The program is open to <u>all</u> students in grades 4-8. Classes will be held in the gym every Tuesday morning, 7:30-8:20am. We had a great sample class



this past Tuesday (9/17). If you missed it, you may still participate. All interested students in grades 4-8 are still invited to join!

In this program, students participate in weekly classes throughout the school year with NHDI teaching artists accompanied by live musicians. The year culminates over Memorial

Day weekend with the Event of the Year production at Redfern Arts Center at KSC, which includes over 300 students from schools throughout the region accompanied by the NHDI orchestra.
