REMINDER ARRIVAL TIME FOR PreK-4

A reminder that this year we have a **new earlier arrival time** for all students in grades PreK-4. Students in grades PreK-4 are now expected to arrive at SJRS <u>by 8:15am.</u> Extended Day (formerly called Child Care) will operate 7:15-8:15am. All students in all grades will go to their classrooms at 8:15am. We have made this change so that the entire school is starting at the same time every day.

The middle school start time remains the same as in the past. Students in grades 5-8 must arrive by 8:15am.

All students must be dropped off at the main entrance of the school when they arrive (not at the playground).

All classes begin <u>promptly</u> at 8:30am. If students arrive to school after 8:30am, they must first go to the Main Office and be signed in by a parent/guardian there.

A reminder that consistent <u>ON TIME arrival every day is essential</u> to the academic process and to achieving the maximum benefit from the SJRS education programs.

Family Faith Formation

The theme of this year's family faith formation program is Christian Prayer, as we follow volume four in the series A Family of Faith. We will be exploring and experiencing various forms of prayer, unpacking the significance of the petitions in the Our Father, drawing closer to our Blessed Mother, and more!

Parents meet monthly to receive teaching, inspiration, and support both for their own faith journey and for guiding their children in lessons at home. There are also opportunities to gather as families in community to live out our faith together.

We encourage all families with children from Kindergarten to middle school to participate in this opportunity to grow and deepen your faith life together. There is always more to learn!

Participation in the program is required for families of children in grades 1-3 or older who are preparing to receive the sacraments of reconciliation (typically, second grade), confirmation and first communion (generally, third grade).

Based on the child development principles of Maria Montessori, CGS is hands-on, contemplative method of religious formation that takes place in a specially prepared space called the atrium. Everything in the atrium is designed to foster exploration and wonder as we work with essential elements of the liturgy and scriptures.

The Good Shepherd calls each of us by name, cares for us, and gives us everything we need. In the atrium we are given the freedom to hear His voice, to get to know Him, and to respond with our whole being.

CGS is an especially beautiful way for children to understand the gift and significance of receiving the sacraments of reconciliation, first communion, and confirmation.

DISMISSAL

SJRS students may be picked up in several ways beginning at 2:50pm. As always, safety is our top priority. Always be aware of students walking in the parking lot and always drive slowly. **Please see the map below as a guide.**

If you are entering the parking lot for dismissal, you <u>must</u> enter via Davis Street (GREEN


ARROW). When exiting, you <u>must</u> exit on the SOUTH side of St. Bernard's Church (GREEN/BLUE ARROWS), unless you are in the rides line.

1. You may park along Wilson Street (YELLOW) and pick up your student. You must walk over and get them directly from the teacher before rides line begins to move. Your child's teacher must know that you are taking them before you do.

2. You may park in the school/church parking lot in the designated area (YELLOW) and walk over to get your child directly from the teacher before rides line begins to move. Your child's teacher must know that you are taking them before you do.

3. You may join the rides line (TWO PARALLEL YELLOW ARROWS) and pick up directly at your car. Your student will be brought to you at your car.

4. If you have a Mercy Academy student, the Mercy student may pick up their siblings at the playground door (known as the "Mercy door") and walk the students to your parked car in the parking lot near the flagpole (**GREEN**).
