Dear Parents and Staff,

Here's the latest news and musings from the principal....

Yesterday at Mass, we recognized the Good Samaritan Award winners from OLMA, recognized for their likeness to the Biblical Samaritan, being helpful, kind, and respectful:

The winners are Madelyn Carlson and Elio Saba!

We also recognized the Junior Class students for their amazing PSAT scores. The PSAT was taken on October 17 with the following results:

OLMA's mean score: 1138 reading/writing: 591 math: 548 State of NH mean score: 1009 reading/writing: 519 math: 490 United States mean score: 1000 reading/writing: 509 math: 491 Global mean score: 1002 reading/writing: 510 math: 492

This means that our students scored 129 points higher overall than the next highest group (the state group), 72 points higher in reading and writing than the next highest group (the state group), and 56 points higher in math than the next highest group (the global group.)

This is one of the main reasons that you send your children to St. Joseph and Our Lady of Mercy, so that they can receive a superior academic foundation for college, career, and life.

Another hallmark of our schools is that we respect our nation and those who serve it in the military branches. We say the Pledge of Allegiance every morning, we remember veterans and those currently in the armed forces, and we pray for them. This week, our students completed 271 for the "Holiday Cards 4 Our Military Challenge". Part of the challenge requires a staff member to read through the cards for approval before they are sent to the challenge's sponsor.

What sentiments from our students... a true reflection of their patriotism and understanding that freedom isn't free. Here are some examples:

"For sacrificing your life to protect our lives and freedom, you are appreciated wholeheartedly."

Finally, we know that the Catholic Christian environment that students experience at St. Joseph and Our Lady of Mercy is the essential element of our Mission. Without it, we would just be a private school that provided a good education. In this regard, we will be remembering Deacon Ken Swymer next week at our weekly school Mass. We will pray a Spiritual Bouquet for him (one Our father, One Hail Mary, One Glory Be) and Ms. Suzanne Foder will offer a brief remembrance of Deacon Ken. He was an important person in our schools and in our Parish, and he is greatly missed. The 8th Graders will also pray a Rosary for him on November 21, the anniversary of his passing, in their religion class. We ask parents to join us by praying for Deacon Ken's eternal soul and for his still grieving family.

The Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer Program (S-EBT) provides families with a one-time payment of \$120 per eligible child to buy food during the summer months when students don't have access to free or reduced-price meals at school. DHHS has



reached out to families that participated in the SNAP, Medicaid, or TANF programs during the 2023-2024 school year and they will be automatically enrolled in S-EBT unless they opt out. Families that participated in the National School Lunch Program but did not participate in SNAP, Medicaid or TANF may also be eligible for S-EBT, but must provide their address through the DHHS portal that will be open November 15 to December 15. 6th pre-made pumpkin pie or apple pie

May they ever experience your firm support, gentle love and compassionate healing. Be their power and protector, leading them from darkness to light.


